Background

- Babyclear implemented since 2013
- SIP Midwife Leads recruited to improve CO monitoring and Referrals
- High rates (75%) of declined or unable to contact
- Training for midwives to improve quality of conversation and referral
- NHS England funding to pilot home visit stop smoking advisers commissioned by CCG



Other Areas within the STP

- Swale Home Visit service (Direct Supply) commissioned by Swale CCG -18.3%
- Medway Unitary
 Authority 17.5%

What is a Home Visit Stop Smoking Support?

- Level 2 trained stop smoking adviser & specialist SIP knowledge
- Adviser contacts referred smoker, offering home based quit support
- Service extends to partners
- Pilot targeted in Thanet & South Kent Coast CCG areas





Referral Pathway

Midwife CO monitors at first booking All CO >4ppm referred to stop smoking service Home Visit areas: Adviser makes contact & offers home visit quit support

Adviser attends appointment: delivers 7 week quit programme (inc partner) Delivers quit programme and additional needs referred on to appropriate services

- Non-Home Visit Service: across Kent (exc. Swale)
- Home Visit Service: in Thanet and SKC areas

- Regular appointments:
 chase referrals

Expand Home Visit Advisers to all 6 CCG areas in Kent from September 2019

+ Swale in April 2020

Aim for 480 quits pa to meet 6% national target by 2022
